\$5.00 per head, limited to financial members of the BBBC.

8 PRIZE CATEGORIES:

Heaviest Snapper	\$100 Fish City Voucher
Heaviest Kingfish	\$50 Fish City Voucher
Heaviest Kahawai	\$30 Fish City Voucher
Heaviest Other Species (excluding Shark, Barracouta, Ray, Snake, Eel)	\$50 Fish City Voucher
Longest length of four legal fish (minimum three different species) caught on one boat laid end to end (excluding Shark, Barracouta, Ray, Snake Eel)	\$50 BBBC Bar Tab

9 RULES

- 9.1 Completed Entry Form **must be signed by each Fisherpersion and Skipper** and be deposited along with the Entry fee(s) in a sealed envelope in the Howie Box (at the rear of the Tractor Shed) **before you launch and no later than 9:30am on the Competition Day**. Note the Entry Form requires details of a designated boat, name of Skipper and a name of each Fisherpersion.
- 9.2 Skippers must **sign out** in the Tractor Log located in the Tractor Shed. Skippers must on return **sign back** in using the Tractor Log. This is to confirm that the boat with all Fisherpersons on board has returned safely.

- 9.3 Designated Fishing Area. Fishing is restricted to those areas on Chart 532, Approaches to Auckland. If the Area for fishing is further restricted to the Waitemata Harbour, launching and retrieval must be from within that area.
- 9.4 No lines are to be in the water before 9:00am or after 12.00pm on the Competition Day.
- 9.5 All fish must be caught on rod and reel or hand line from the designated boat referred to in the Entry Form.
- 9.6 No lines shall have more than three hooks.
- 9.7 All fish must be of legal size and comply with the size restrictions outlined by the Ministry for Primary Industries. You may download the Ministry for Primary Industries Fishing Rules from their website www.mpi.govt.nz.
- 9.8 Weigh-in will open at 12:30 hours on the Competition Day.
- 9.9 Weigh-in will close at 13:30 hours on the Competition Day. If you are not in line with your fish by 13:30 hours you will not be eligible for the prizes.
- 9.10 Only one fish per Prize Category will be measured for each Fisherperson.
- 9.11 All decisions of the Event Committee shall be final.
- 9.12 All Fisherpersons must be present at the prize giving in order to claim a prize. If not, at the prize giving the prize will be awarded for the next heaviest fish in the relevant Prize Category.
- 9.13 By entering the Competition Fisherpersons agree to their name being published and to being photographed for the purpose of a record of the Competition and/or promoting future Competitions and/or BBBC generally.
- 9.14 By entering into this competition and participating, each Fisherperson agrees to be bound by these Rules and the Event Committee's decisions.
- 9.15 The Snapper Sprint will start at 09.00 and end at 12.00 on the Competition Day
- 9.16 All competitor's boats must start in the water at Browns Bay Beach, inside the line of 200 metre bouys off the beach. A hooter will sound at 09.00 indicating the start of the Snapper Sprint.
- 9.17 All competitor's boats must return to Browns Bay beach, inside the line of 200 metre bouys off the beach by 12.00pm on the Competition day. A hooter will sound at 12.00pm indicating the end of the Snapper Sprint.

10 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND DISCLAIMER

- 10.1 To the extent permitted by law, you agree that neither BBBC, its Officers and Committee Members, personnel or the Event Committee shall be liable in any way for any loss or damage suffered, or for any personal injury or death suffered or sustained in connection with the Competition or your participation in the Competition, regardless of cause.
- 10.2 As Skipper of the designated boat you confirm that:
- The boat is seaworthy and suitable for the Competition, for the activities to be undertaken and for the number of persons you will have on board; and

- You will operate the boat in a safe manner at all times and comply with all Maritime Rules and Laws and Local Authority By-laws including (but not limited to) the carrying of and wearing of (as may be required) correct fitting lifejackets.

11 POSTPONEMENT/EARLY WEIGH-IN/CANCELLATION

- 11.1 The Event Committee will assess various Auckland marine weather forecasting services and determine if it is safe to hold the Competition. Safety and an enjoyable day on the water is the Event Committees priority.
- 11.2 Depending on the forecasts, the area of fishing may be restricted to such as the inner Waitemata Harbour.
- 11.3 Postponement, cancellation or restrictions on the fishing area will be advised by 8:00pm on the night prior to the Event. These will be notified by notice on the Marine Centre Door, MailChimp and/or the www.bbbc.co.nz website. If in doubt call any of the Event Committee whose numbers are as above.
- 11.4 The Event Committee may subsequently postpone the Event or call for early Weigh-in at any time if weather conditions turn adverse. If an early Weigh-in is called for it will be communicated via Channel 6 and/or your Skippers mobile number.
- 11.5 If postponed, the Event Committee will decide and advise an alternate day being the Postponement Day.
